<b>Preparedness</b>	Student is completely prepared and has obviously rehearsed.	Student seems fairly prepared but might have needed a couple more rehearsals.	The student is somewhat prepared, but it is clear that rehearsal was lacking.	Student does not seem at all prepared to present.

<b>Vocabulary</b>	Extends audience vocabulary by defining words that might be new to most of the audience. Includes several words in Spanish with proper pronunciation.	Includes 1-2 words that might be new to most of the audience, but does not define them. Includes some words in Spanish with proper pronunciation.	Does not include any vocabulary that might be new to the audience. Includes 1-2 words in Spanish and/or does not use proper pronunciation.	Uses several words or phrases that are not understood by the audience. No effort to use words in Spanish.
<b>Content</b>	Shows a full understanding of the topic. Topic is completely relevant to Spanish-speaking heritage.	Shows a good understanding of the topic. Topic is fairly relevant to Spanish-speaking heritage.	Shows a good understanding of parts of the topic. Topic is somewhat relevant to Spanish-speaking heritage.	Does not seem to understand the topic very well. Topic is not relevant to Spanish-speaking heritage.
<b>Comprehension</b>	Student is able to accurately answer almost all questions posed by classmates about the topic.	Student is able to accurately answer most questions posed by classmates about the topic.	Student is able to accurately answer a few questions posed by classmates about the topic.	Student is unable to accurately answer questions posed by classmates about the topic.
